BRAIN HEALTH STUDY

Enrolling now for a study that uses a new method for early detection of Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias. The Digital Detection of Dementia (D3) study aims to see if our method of early detection may help people with dementia and their care partners plan for the future.

WHO MAY QUALIFY?

Adults **65 years or older** who:

- Do not have any history of memory problems
- Are able to communicate in English or Spanish
- Have had at least one visit to their primary care practice within the past year

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- One time visit to our clinic in Boca Raton, FL
- Completion of surveys
- In-person assessments of health and cognition
- A study partner (over the phone or in person) that can answer questions about the participant

IS THERE COMPENSATION?

- **\$50** each for the participant and their study partner after the visit is completed
